## THE STORY OF THE EAST TIMOR EYE PROGRAM

The East Timor Eye Program is a volunteer service which works to give the gift of sight back to the people of East Timor. Since 2000, the program has performed 3300 surgeries to remove cataracts and restore sight.

More than 28,000 pairs of glasses have been prescribed.

And 33,000 people have visited the clinics run by the program's volunteers in the capital Dili and many regional centres across the country. Our teams of ophthalmologists, nurses and optometrists have worked for eight years to provide these services to the people of East Timor.

They have been supported by dozens of non-medical volunteers and fundraisers.

Our mission is to make East Timor self-sufficient in eye care by 2015, and to eradicate preventable blindness by 2020.
